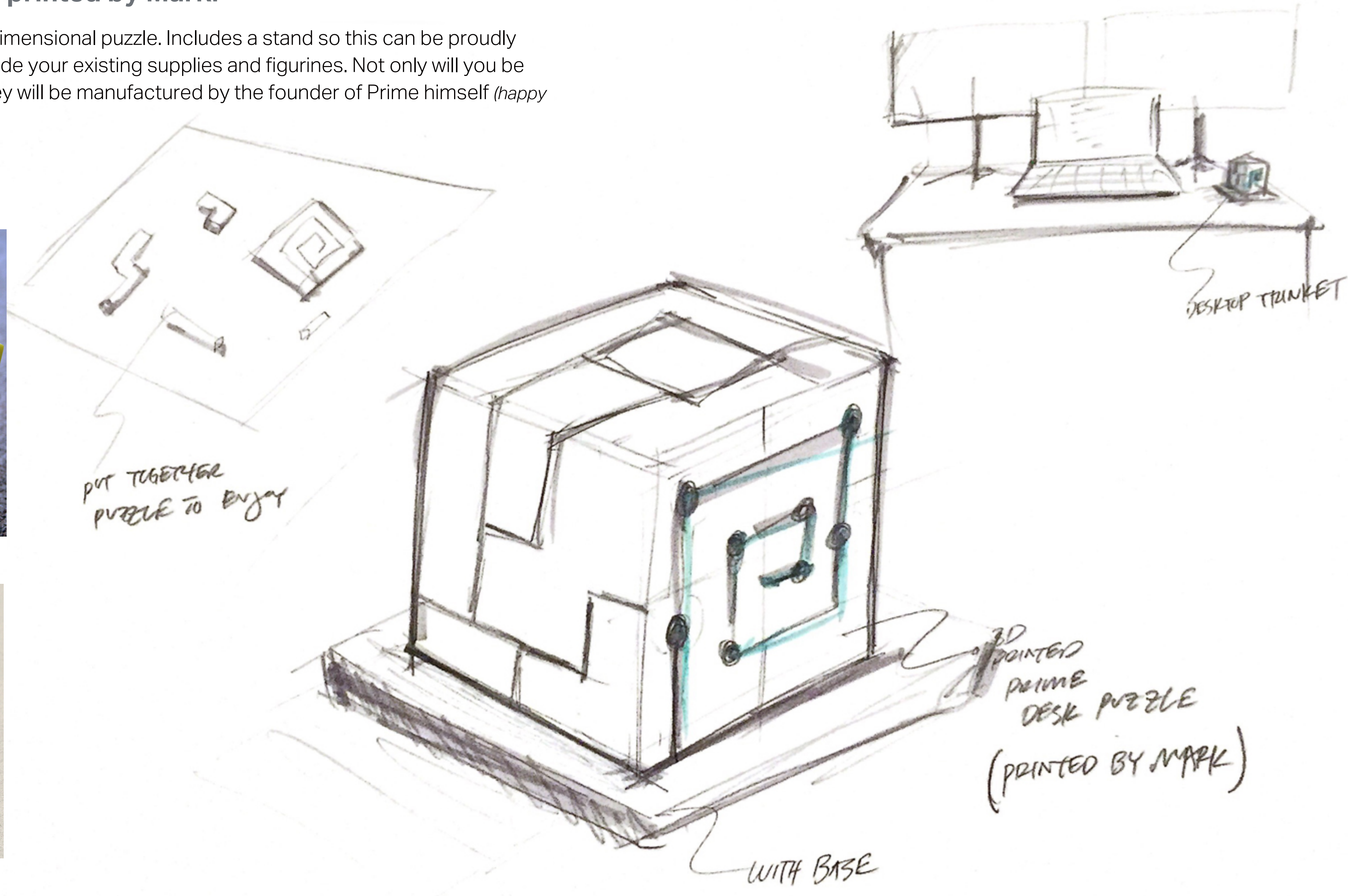
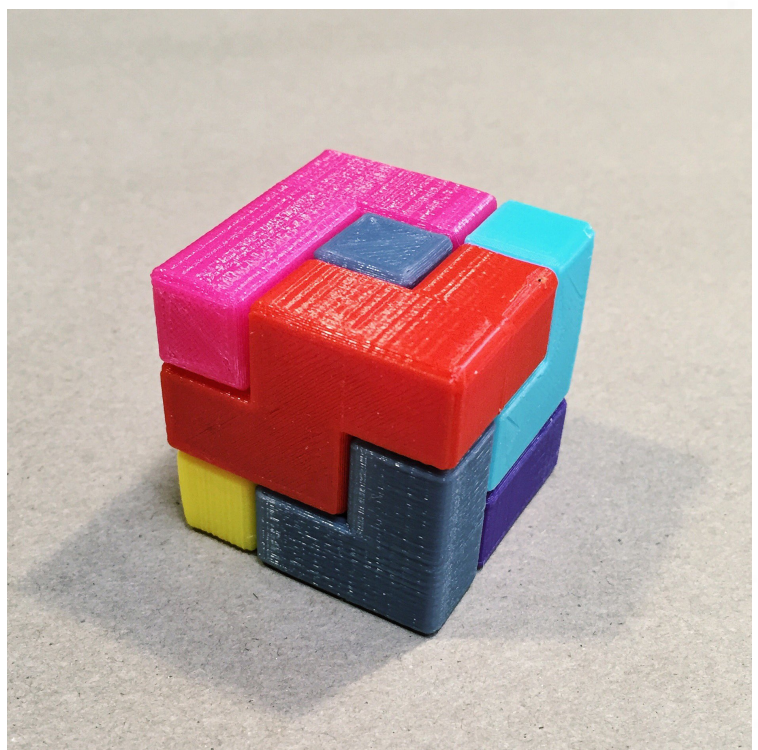
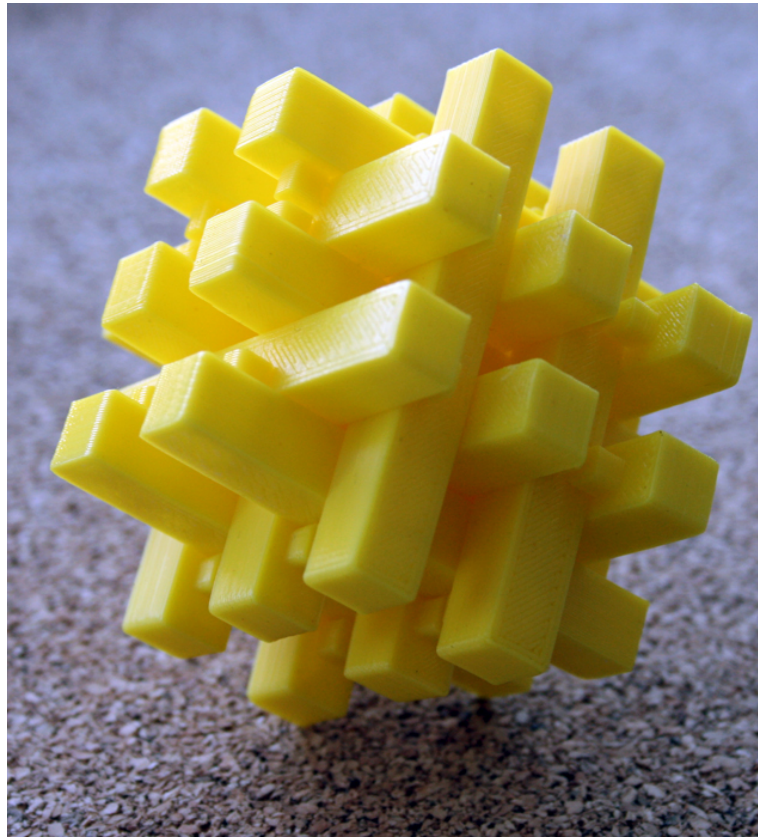
3D Trinket

- Colors should reflect Prime branding, but not all Teal

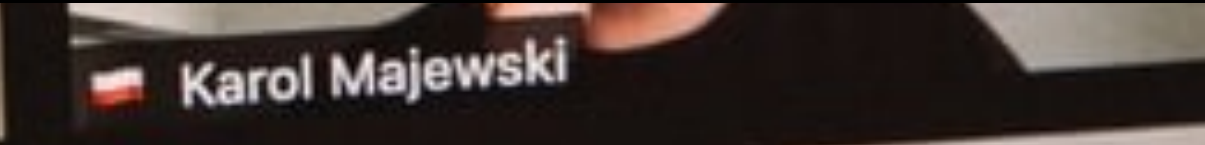
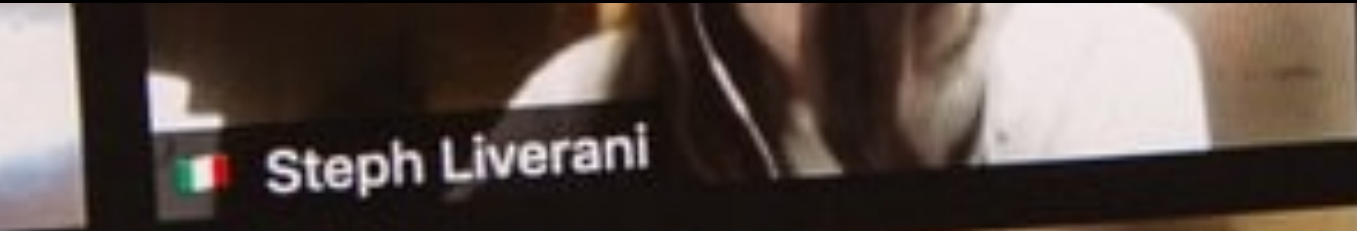
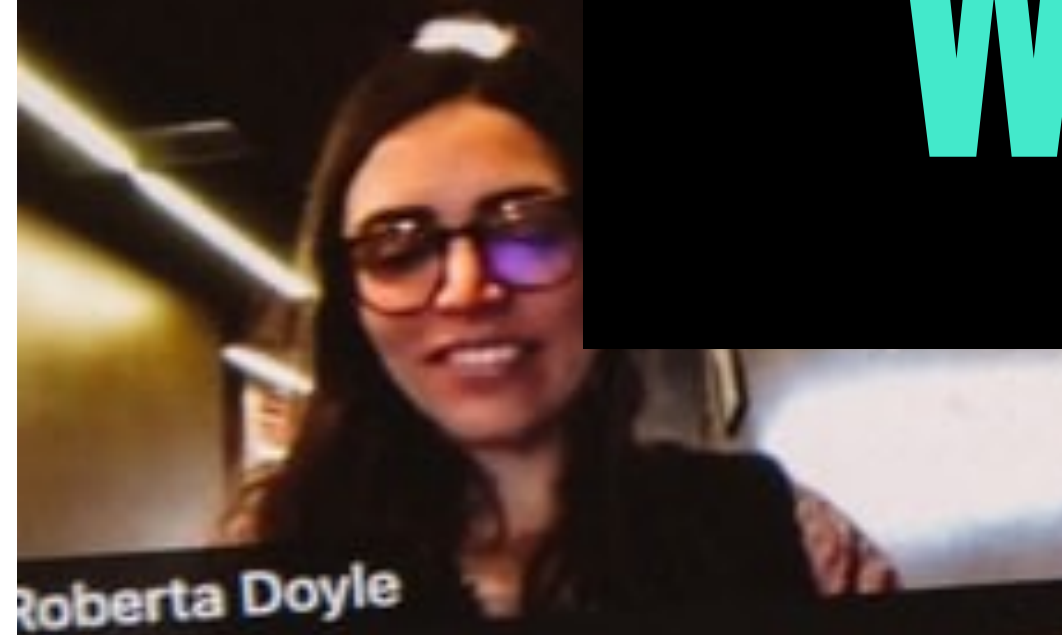
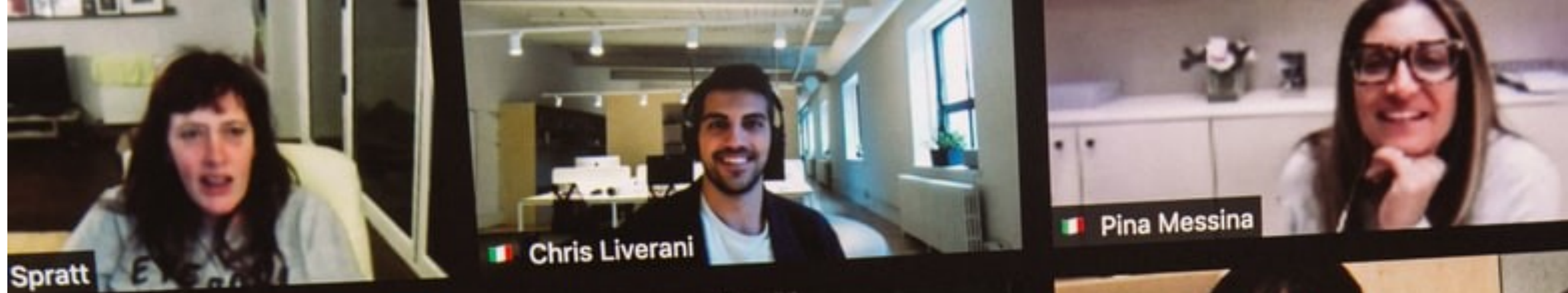
